

The Bel Canto Board has determined the following requirements for the Bel Canto Senior Singers to sing in person beginning the fall of 2021.

1. All Senior Singers will show evidence of vaccination in order to sing in person (i.e., show their vaccination card, a picture of their card, or validation via the [Wisconsin Immunization Registry](#)). *Bel Canto will track confirmation of vaccination status, but will not retain copies of any documents.*
2. Any non-vaccinated singers, or singers not wanting to verify vaccination, will only be permitted to participate in rehearsals and performances virtually. *This will be the protocol for the 2021-2022 season, and could be revisited as warranted based on potential changes to guidance/protocols.*
3. All in-person singers will wear masks while in the rehearsal buildings, as well as during rehearsal, in order to adhere to the latest CDC recommendations and the [City of Milwaukee mask advisory](#). *This will be the going-in protocol for the fall season, and could be revisited as warranted based on potential changes to guidance/protocols.*
4. All in-person singers will sign a liability waiver at the start of the season and prior to each season *until it would be determined at a later date that this is no longer needed.*
5. Outside of the above, Bel Canto Senior Singers will follow any other protocol as stipulated by rehearsal sites, including but not limited to distancing, ventilation, etc. *This will be the going-in protocol and could be revisited as warranted based on potential changes to guidance/protocols.*
